



## Discoverability Checklist

Let us help you and your patrons get the most out of **SAGE Catalyst**! Here are our top tips for increasing discoverability of your important content:

### Adding SAGE Catalyst products to your catalog and library websites

- ☑ **List each title in the SAGE Catalyst collection using the MARC Records.** MARC records can be downloaded from SecureCenter, so titles can be fully catalogued and made discoverable to university patrons. This is the main route students will find the textbooks. When a patron finds a SAGE Catalyst title in the library search results, it opens in the Talis reader in a flat EPUB format without the Talis Elevate interactivity capabilities.
  
- ☑ **Promote your institution's SAGE Catalyst discovery layer**, hosted on the Talis platform. All university patrons can access the discovery layer and browse titles by discipline, or search by title, author and ISBN.
  
- ☑ Appoint a "super user"
  - Help your patrons get to grips with the platform by offering resource training

- ☑ Use the recommended production description
