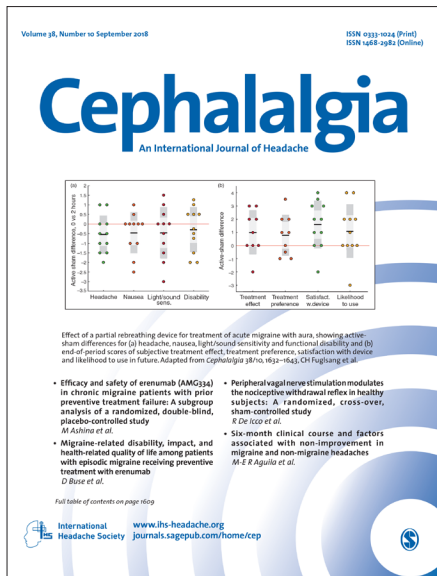

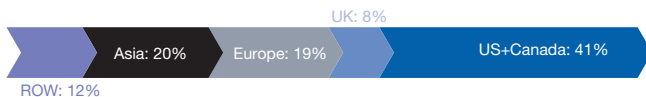

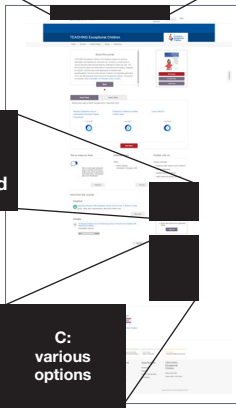
Inserts: Bound inserts, loose inserts, gatefolds, tip-ins and die cuts are

Digital advertising solutions:

- **A: 728x90 Leaderboard** (pictured) top of page ad position for immediate exposure
- **B: 300x250 Banner Ad** (pictured) middle right of page to engage the most invested users
- **C: Either 300x250 banner ad (pictured), 160x600 skyscraper, or 300x600 expandable skyscraper.** Lower middle, right of page

Digital ad upgrades:

- **Rich media:** include active images or text
- **Expandability:** upgrade any ads to expand over or push down content
- **Video:** upgrade any ads with embedded video for greater engagement
- **Form/lead capture:** upgrade any ads with a contact information form for lead capture

Other digital solutions:

- **Webinars:** a custom digital event package that includes promotion and event hosting
- **eTOC alerts:** Leaderboard ad sponsorship of new issue email alerts sent to subscribers
- **Content gateways:** custom package to host your content and SAGE content in one place

Cancellations must be submitted in writing and will not be accepted after closing dates for space reservations. Any cancellations after the deadlines will be charged in full.

All advertising is subject to the publisher's and society's approval. The advertiser and/or advertising agency assume liability for all contents of advertising and any claims against the publisher as the result of the advertisement.

If artwork cannot be provided by the above deadlines or an extension approved by the publisher, then the publisher will run the most recent artwork submitted.

If no artwork is on hand, then the advertiser will still be responsible for payment on the space reserved.

Mechanical requirements for print advertisements

282mm (h) x 216mm (w)

Half Page

Horizontal, Type Area
120mm (h) x 180mm (w)

Horizontal, Trim Area
140mm (h) x 210mm (w)

Vertical, Type Area
250mm (h) x 85mm (w)

Vertical, Trim Area
280mm (h) x 105mm (w)

Double Spread

Double page spreads need to be supplied as a full PDF page per advert, and not a joined spread of both. The dimensions remain as per

normal full page adverts, including the bleed and cropmark requirements.

Requirements for electronic delivery

Please submit advertisements as print-ready PDFS. Crop marks should be placed on all advertisements that bleed and offset.

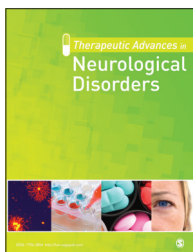
All colour and greyscale graphics should be a minimum of 300 dpi at the finished size.

Colour graphics must be in CMYK.
